Larry Andico, 56 Mountainview Avenue:

- Mr. Andico questioned the Engineer's salary, reviewing the bill list, is it an hourly rate? The Mayor explained billed by project; some grant money is received and we have a firm for the Borough, more than one engineer is working at any time. Mr. Andico feels we should hire a full-time engineer.
- Mr. Andico questioned the charge for the police study on the bill list. Ms. Sandler explained that was a bill from Nisovoccia and Company for the financial study that the Council authorized.

Gayle Livecchia, 29 Brookside Lane:

- Ms. Livecchia questioned Borough Holidays, believes day after Thanksgiving shouldn't be a holiday. Employees should use personal or vacation time and this would save the Borough money. Ms. Livecchia questioned how holidays are determined. Mary Secola asked if she could answer that question as a former employee. Mrs. Secola advised many years prior employees requested to give up Columbus Day in lieu of the day after Thanksgiving and the Council approved the request.
- Ms. Livecchia questioned content of minutes. Mayor explained minutes are not verbatim; they are summarized.
- Ms. Livecchia had requested a response from Mr. Ehrenburg, questioned why she had not heard from him as of yet. Councilwoman Mulligan also wanted to know why Mr. Ehrenburg had not responded to Ms. Livecchia. Ms. Sandler

said she told Mr. Ehrenburg about the request; but we cannot make him respond.

- Ms. Livecchia did not think the Borough should recommend Mr. Ehrenburg if asked by other municipalities.

Veronica Silkes, 668 Succasunna Road:

- Ms. Silkes Reviewed Mine Hill information, inquired about Police Pension System (PFRS) payment schedule.

- Ms. Silkes asked if disbanding the police force would save in civil liabilities and asked what past civil liabilities the Borough had incurred. Ms. Sandler explained that only nuisance settlements had been paid out in the past several years.

- Ms. Silkes asked about resolution for Mr. Joseph Kovalcik, advised he was a part time financial consultant.

- Ms. Silkes questioned overtime for safety purpose for police, not discussed as this is an internal issue.

Mary Secola, 361 Howard Boulevard:

- Mrs. Secola asked whether attorneys representing the Borough, Bell and Gage, are still the Borough attorneys. Ms. Sandler explained that Special Counsel, Fred Semrau, had been hired for various issues. Special Counsel professional agreement is for the year, for any issues. Mrs. Gage advised Mrs. Secola certain issues are still in litigation and not for discussion.

- Ms. Livecchia questioned requirements for Certified Financial Officer position and was advised a graduate degree is not required, state law only requires must be Certified as a Municipal Finance Officer. Councilwoman Cerasoli feels old schedule of meetings and workshops was more effective. Second meeting of the month would be a workshop, beginning at 7:00. Councilman Doran confirms resolutions would be approved only once a month. Councilwoman Mulligan confirms the meetings would be open to the public. Council agrees this item will be tabled for the next meeting.
 2. Policy on document requests by Council Members. – does Council want to use OPRA forms if Councilmembers make requests for information, other than when on behalf of the entire Council? Councilman Driscoll and

Councilwoman Cerasoli suggest possibly a log of requests. Councilman Doran concerned about amount of time employees need to fulfill these requests. Log book would show this information. Councilwoman Mulligan – had to have someone pick up information for her, unusual circumstance, called the Clerk and ask if that would be acceptable. Also asked that information, while public information, be in a sealed envelope. The Clerk told Councilwoman Mulligan that would be okay. Ms. Sendler indicated that while Councilwoman Mulligan asked all the right questions, she was given the wrong information as some of the information was in fact confidential (i.e. legal bills need to be reviewed by attorneys for possible redaction). Councilmembers do not object to a third party picking up information for a Councilmember, and that should be indicated on the logbook. Information should be in a sealed envelope, and redacted if necessary.

Rich Allocca, Borough Risk Manager to give presentation for NJIIF 2008-2010. Explains comparisons of bids between Garden State, Morris County and NJIIF programs. Garden State coverage would parallel current, however, they consider the Borough too small to have an equal vote. Morris County cannot provide comparable coverage. NJIIF is Mr. Allocca's recommendation, have added a loss/control program, seminars. Councilwoman Mulligan – deductible the same? Yes, per Mr. Allocca. \$5,000. Some are "first dollar" i.e. auto liability, general liability, worker's compensation there are no deductible. Ms. Sendler – loss control seminars? For whom? Mr. Allocca – cross training recommended, anyone you choose can attend. Councilman Doran - 7% increase in rate? Mr. Allocca, yes. Other factors as well, rating base driven by payroll (state law) general liability, worker's compensation, cars, heavy equipment all add to cost. Councilman Doran – payroll based on number of people or dollar amount? Mr. Allocca based on dispersion, number of people at each location for calculation. Mr. Allocca available for any further questions from the Council.
